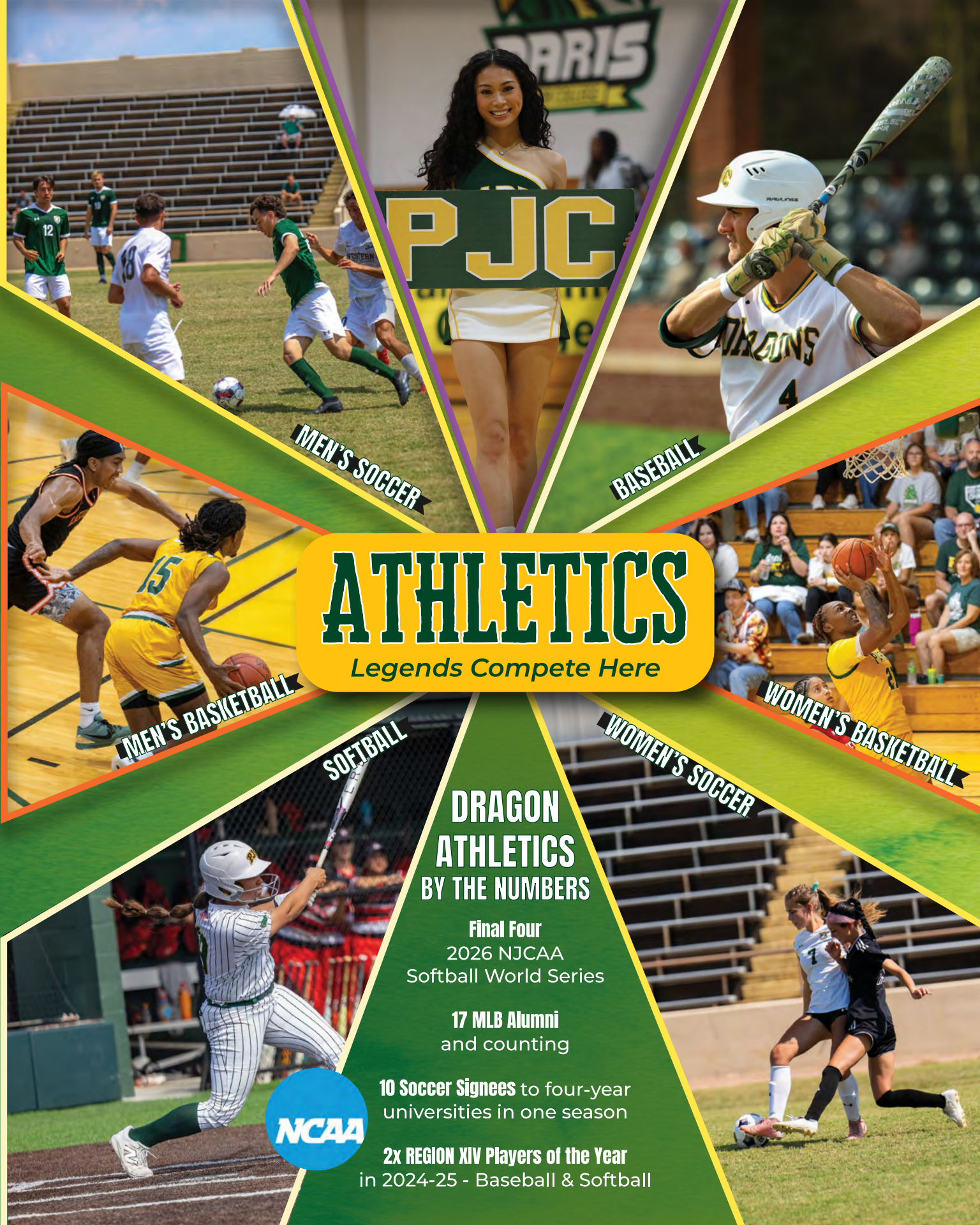

Every Dragon gets a support team — free with enrollment.

TUTORING & WRITING CENTER: Stuck on a concept or polishing a paper? Free tutoring and writing help are built into your PJC experience, not an extra charge.

LIBRARY & LEARNING RESOURCES CENTER: More than books: research databases, eBooks, study space, and staff who'll actually help you find what you need — from campus or your phone.

- APPLY EARLY.** File by priority date for the strongest consideration. Aid is awarded while funds last.

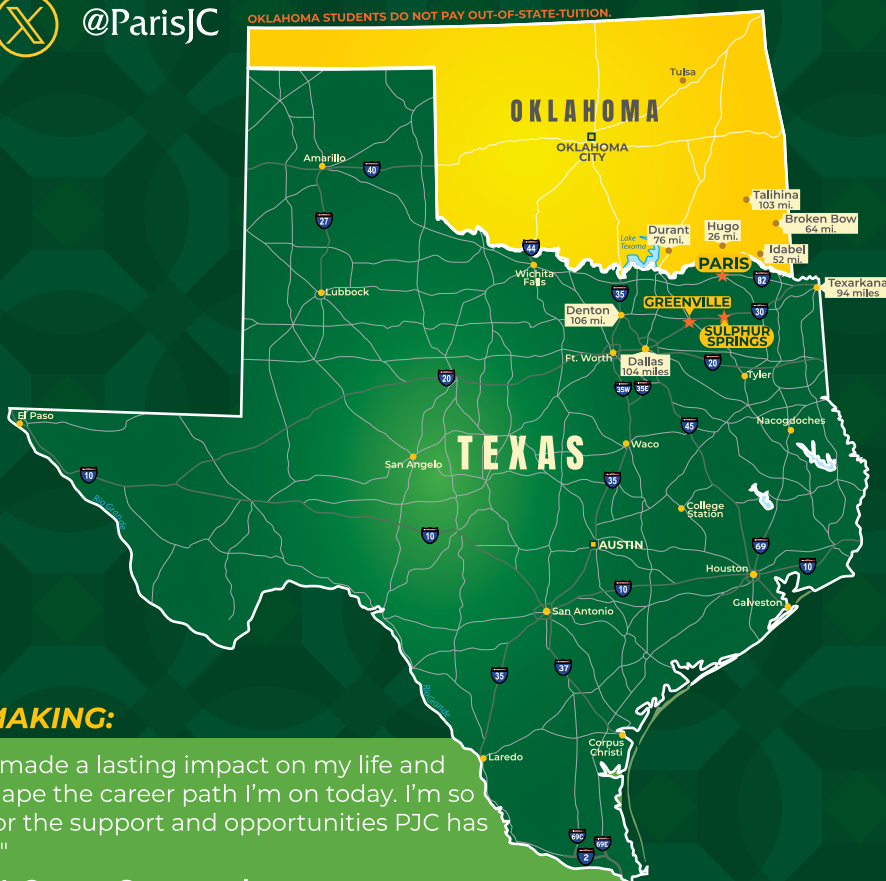
